

CORRECTION TO ANNUAL REGULATORY PLAN

In the annual regulatory plans for 2016-2017 and 2017-2018, the Department of State identified the following law as requiring rulemaking:

In the annual regulatory plans for 2016-2017 and 2017-2018, the Department of State identified Chapter 2016-23, Laws of Florida, law as requiring rulemaking. After two rule development workshops for Rule 1S-2.039, Florida Voter Registration Procedures, it was determined that while the law specified in more detail elements of an address that facilitate verification of a residential street address, these data elements would already be considered and in place based on existing requirements for Supervisors of Elections to verify whether a residential street address for a voter is valid or not. Therefore, the Department of State's annual regulatory plans for 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 are corrected to reflect that rules are not necessary at this time to further implement Chapter 2016-23, Laws of Florida.


